Please consider the submission below of the above Climate Change Regulations:

Schedule 2, Table 4 refers to the emissions factors associated with importation of natural gas which includes Propane, Butane and LPG (P60:B40). Our submission is that, while we may import or export any of these three alternatives, we may also import or export a combination of the either propane or butane that does not have a 60:40 ratio.

As a result, we submit that we should be able to calculate the emissions factor for any import/export based on the actual combination of propane and butane in the mix and not be limited to the three options currently provided in the regulations.
